However, as we strive for excellence in every aspect of our business we are committed to minimising the environmental impacts of the business operation.

### Our stated aims are to:

- 1.1 Aim to continuously improve our environmental performance particularly with regards to our recycling and re-use of paper.
- 1.2 Reduce the amount of non-recyclable waste we generate from our packaging.
- 1.3 All confidential paperwork to be shredded and recycled.
- 1.4 Reduce our consumption of resources and improve the efficiency of those resources by printing double sided where practicable
- 1.5 Manage waste generated from our business operations according to the principles of reduction, re-use and recycling
- 1.6 Recycle all waste ink and toner cartridges.
- 1.7 Work with our delivery partners to continue to reduce our carbon footprint for transporting goods.
- 1.8 Aim to increase the number of electric vehicles used in our fleet where practicable.
- 1.9 Comply as a minimum with all relevant environmental legislation as well as other environmental requirements.
